# Submission Guidelines and How to Enter

- 1. The contest is open until **December 31st**, 2023.
- 2. All entries must be submitted electronically as a **JPG or PDF** file to the Japanese email: <a href="mailto:kcjlangcont@gmail.com">kcjlangcont@gmail.com</a>
- 3. Submissions must include:
  - ✓ Your full name and "T-shirt design" in the title of the email
  - ✓ Your high school, college or university
  - ✓ Your personal email address and phone number (so that we can reach you for design revisions)
  - ✓ Your postal address (we will send the winner a free T-shirt)
- 4. One or more submissions per person is acceptable. Each submission must be sent in a separate email.
- 5. There is no fee to enter the contest.
- 6. The artwork must be original and not AI generated.

# T-shirt Design Guidelines and Parameters

The purpose of this contest is to select a T-shirt design for the 2024 Heartland Japanese Language Contest.

- ▶ The design should be Japanese dragons and the theme of 勇気.
- ➤ The design should include the following text: 2024 Heartland Japanese Language Contest, 第 2 6 回 日本語コンテスト
- Entries must be submitted as JPEG or PDF files. For quality reproduction purposes, the winning entry will later be converted into a scalable vector graphic format (EPS).
- > The design can include up to 3 colors (CMYK). Please note however, that one color will be selected as the T-shirt color. Contestants are advised to avoid gradients and half-tones.
- > The design is subject to modification based on the suggestions and needs of the contest organizing committee. Please email any questions for clarification.

#### **Intellectual Property**

- 1. Entrants affirm their submissions are their own original work and do not violate the intellectual property rights of any other person or entity.
- 2. Submissions become the sole property of the Japanese Language Contest committee and may be used on websites, letterhead, posters, banners, and other materials.

#### **Determination of Winner and Prize**

- 1. The winning entry will be selected by a panel comprised of Japanese Language Contest organizers.
- 2. The winning entry will be selected based on the following criteria: (a) visual appeal, (b) adherence to the language contest concepts, (c) quality of design, and (d) ease of reproduction.
- 3. The winner will be notified via email and recognized at their institution and the Heart of America Japan America Society website and related social media. The winner will be given a free T-shirt of their winning design.

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
